









COVID 19 statistics

- Data for COVID-19 Deaths (from earlier this week)
 - National: 80,684 deaths total; 28,100 are Nursing Home (NH) residents = 35%
 - State of FL: 1735 deaths total; 570 are NH residents = 33%
 - State of CO: 987 deaths total; 529 are NH residents = 54%
 - Pinellas County: 61 deaths total; 41 are NH residents = 67%
 - This includes the #1 home in FL for deaths, and is still losing residents every day
- The Total Population of NH residents in the US is about 0.5% of the Total US Population
 - However, as noted above responsible for 35% of the deaths nationwide
 - Based on this data, the death rate of our residents is about 70 times that of the rest of the US. In some FL counties, it is over 100 times the rate.

Clinical Landscape

- Our ISNP operates in 173 facilities total; 72 are COVID positive buildings, which is 42%
 - 21 of these 72 facilities have 5 or more of our patients who are COVID positive (12% of all facilities)
- Keep in mind that required reporting of deaths in our homes was not mandated to start nationwide until last Fri, May 8th
 - Therefore the data has been very spotty depending on the individual state requirements
 - The first report due to be released by the US Government on this data nationwide is not expected until June 1st.






