


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Level of Community Transmission of All Counties in US



Percentage of Residents in Nursing Homes with Complete COVID-19 Vaccination Receiving Additional Primary or Booster Dose, by Week – United States



Percentage of Staff in Nursing Homes with Complete COVID-19 Vaccination Receiving Additional Primary or Booster Dose, by State and Week – United States




Percentage of Staff in Nursing Homes with Complete COVID-19 Vaccination Receiving Additional Primary or Booster Dose, by State and Week – United States





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
